ACADEMICS

English

LIFE SKILLS (CIRCLE TIME)

Circle time is a fun portion of the school day, first thing in the morning.

During the circle time, students sit on a mat in a circle with the teacher in the centre. Teacher is in close proximity with the students. Students can make an eye contact with teacher and establish good peer bonding by sitting close to each other.

Some of the activities done during this time are:

- Ask the child to support you in simple things like keeping plates, keeping the toys away after play.
- Ask your child to tell you about his/her friends in school.
- Sing rhymes with your child and enjoy.
