ACADEMICS

English

- Pre-writing: beading, clay modelling, scribbling, colouring, finger exercises, pattern tracing and writing
- Development of listening and speaking skills through fun activities, dramatisation, puppetry and free conversations
- Following simple instructions
- Recognition, phonic sound, vocabulary and writing of letters 'a', 'p', 'n' and 'i' through rhymes and flash cards, word wall and games
- Identify words which have the sound of 'a', 'p', 'n' and 'i'
- Rhymes: 'Rabbit went Paris', 'Papa, the great', 'Pencil my friend' and 'Billu's Wig' (Garden of Verses)

LIFE SKILLS (CIRCLE TIME)
