With rejuvenated energy after the summer break, we look forward to make learning even more exciting and effective for Prideens. The following will be covered under academics, talents and lifeskills.

ACADEMICS

English

- Reading simple text using letter-sound relationship by segmenting (breaking down) and blending (combining) letters and sight vocabulary
- Writing simple words using letter-sound relationship and sight vocabulary
- Enhancing vocabulary through free conversations, text reading, dramatisation and puppetry
- Answering simple questions and following instructions
- Representing ideas and thoughts using drawing and simple words
- Recognition and writing letters E, F, G and H
- **Song:** Jump! Jump! Jump!
- **Story:** Tus and Tini

हिंदी

- कविता पठन- 'क', 'ई', 'स' वर्णों से परिचय कराना
 - लेखन हेतु गतिविधियाँ- बिंदु मिलान, चित्र बनाना, रंग भरना, अक्षरों से शब्द बनाना
 - सरल प्रश्नों के उत्तर देना
 - शब्द-भित्तिका व फ्लैश कार्ड्स की सहायता से अक्षर की चिह्न, ध्वनि, बनावट व शब्दों से परिचित कराना
 - बच्चों को लिखित और मौखिक रूप से पर्याप्त अभ्यास कराना
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- कविताएँ- 'कोयल और कौआ', 'ईद', 'सर्दी भगाओ' (कविता के मोती)
 - 'ईला की नानी' कहानी में उन वर्णों से बने शब्दों का उपयोग किया गया है जो अभी तक बच्चों को सिखाए गए हैं। इस कहानी का उद्देश्य बच्चों की वर्णों पर बनी समझ को जानना और परखना है।

Math

- Positional Vocabulary: On and Under
- Number - Recognition, quantification and writing of numbers till 13

Theme Based Learning

- **Theme- Animals**
 - Observing animals
 - Comparing patterns on the bodies of animals
 - Counting animals
 - Animals and their young ones
 - Sounds of animals
 - Classification of animals as one that flies, lives on land and water
 - Taking care of animals
 - Spatial vocabulary-inside/outside, on/under
- **Story:** Farm Party, Bark George
- **Rhyme:** चिड़ियाँ
- **Song:** Animal Sounds, Going to Zoo Tomorrow

Art and Craft

- Animals using thumb impressions
- Colouring
- Spray painting

ICT

- Games - to enhance clicking and dragging of mouse and the skill of observation and matching.

LIFE SKILLS (CIRCLE TIME)

Circle time is the most comfortable time when the class comes together for sharing, enjoyment and celebration. The focus is on development of socio-emotions skills like being independent, taking initiative, self expression, sharing.

Some activities covered during this time are:

- Sign-in activity and helpers of the day
- Simon says
- Antakshari
- News of the Day
- Sharing
- Songs and stories

What YOU can do to help your child learn better:

- Ask your child to try to write his/her mother's and father's name. The child might not be able to write independently. Support him/her. In case the name consists of a different phonic sound as done by him/her earlier, take this is an opportunity to tell the other sound of a particular letter. As in 'Ritika', 'r' has the sound of 'रि' and 'a' has the sound of 'आ'
- Play 'Simon Says' with your child where the child will follow the instruction if it is prefixed with Simon says. For example if you say jump the child will not perform the action but when you say Simon says jump she/he jumps.
- Spend some time everyday with your child to discuss the experiences at school and home, talk about good eating habits, importance of hygiene and respect for elders.
- Read various stories to them during bed time.
