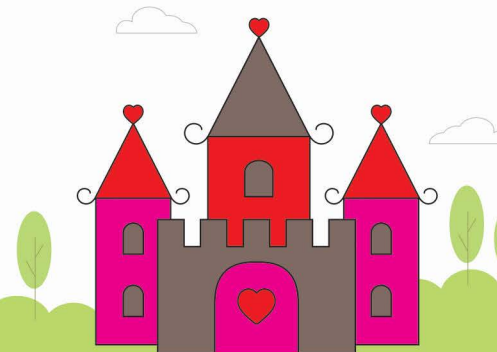
ACADEMICS

English

- Developing the skills of listening and speaking through fun activities, dramatisation, puppetry and free conversations
- Following simple instructions
- Developing the skills of recognition, phonic sound, vocabulary and writing of letters 'h', 'e', 'm' and 'd' through rhymes and flash cards, word wall and games
- Identifying words which have the sound of 'h', 'e', 'm' and 'd'
- Rhymes: 'Ants and the honey', 'Eddy Meddy', 'Nani's Home' and 'Story Time with Daddy' (Garden of Verses)
- Making and writing words using letter-sound relationship and sight vocabulary

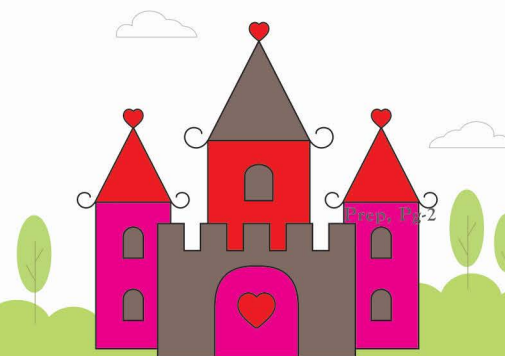
- Mathematics**

LIFE SKILLS (CIRCLE TIME)

Students at this age learn by interacting and being with each other. Circle time is one such opportunity. The focus this month will be on developing listening skills, being attentive and building a bond with their peer group.

Some activities that students will do this month are as follows:

- Who is at the door?
- Body orchestra
- Simon says
- To take initiative
- To share experiences with classmates



What YOU can do to help your child learn better:

- Use a household task as a chance to practise listening and following one, two and three-step directions. For example, 'Pick up your shoes'. As they become better at following one step directions, graduate to the tasks with additional steps. Examples of two and three step direction are, 'Pick up your shoes and put them in your room', 'Take the milk from the kitchen, finish it and put the glass back in the kitchen.'
- Play games like, 'Simon Says'. The child has to do what you ask him/her to do but only if it is prefixed with 'Simon Says'. For example, If you say 'Touch your nose', the child should not touch it. But if you say 'Simon says touch your nose', then the child should touch it.
- Spend some time everyday when the entire family sits together and talks to the child. Let the child experience the family bond and importance of each family member. Involve the child in important discussions. Provide him/her space to share his/her experiences and express his/her views.
