English

- Developing the skills of recognition, phonic sound, vocabulary and writing of letters 'x', 'q' and 'v' through rhymes, flash cards, word wall and games
- Identifying words that have the sound of 'x', 'q' and 'v' through various games and activities
- Rhymes: Ox and fox, Quack quack duck and Veera, the Brave.
- · Cluster ending story: Animals having fun
- · Making and writing simple words using letter-sound relationship and sight vocabulary
- Reciting and writing sequence of letters from a to z
